1. Introduction

This Operational Notice outlines the temporary suspension of Out of Hours Flying on Saturday 6th June due to a private event taking place on the airfield.

2. Background

High-powered vehicles will be operating on runways and taxiways throughout the event. These vehicles will have unrestricted access and will be manoeuvring at high speeds. Because of this activity, it will not be safe for aircraft to manoeuvre, depart, or land during the affected period.

3. Operations

All aircraft must land by 17:40L.

No aircraft movements of any kind will be permitted after 18:00L. This includes take-off, landing, and taxiing.

During the private event, vehicles will have unrestricted access to runways and taxiways, making aircraft manoeuvring prohibited.

Fire Crew and Air Traffic will remain on duty to monitor the event and ensure compliance with the airfield closure.

Any aircraft attempting to manoeuvre or land will be reminded that the airfield is closed. Continued attempts to manoeuvre will be referred to Airport Management, and an MOR will be raised by the airport authority.

The fuel bay will close to aircraft at 17:50L.

Pedestrians must exercise extra caution if walking airside after 18:00L.
